



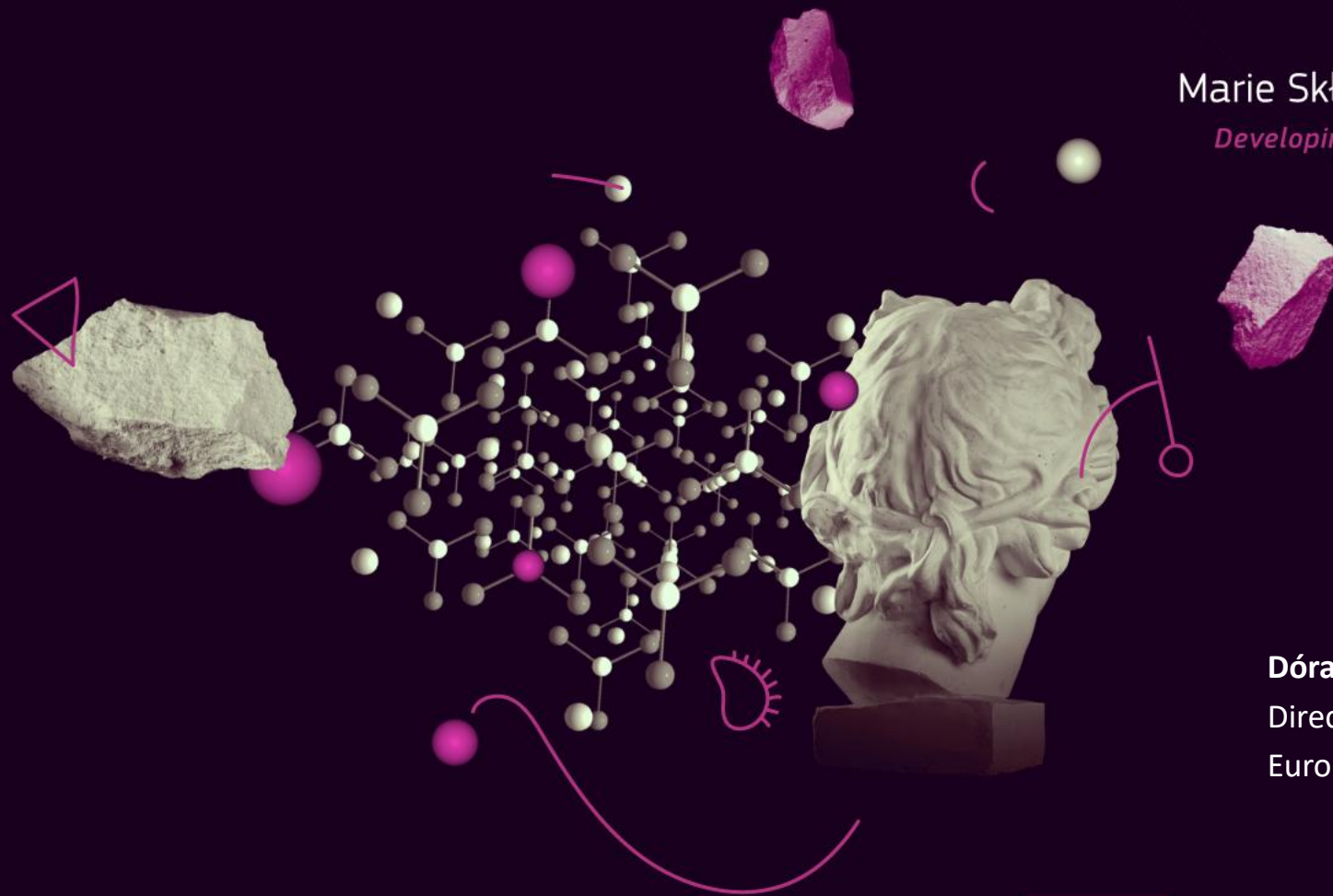

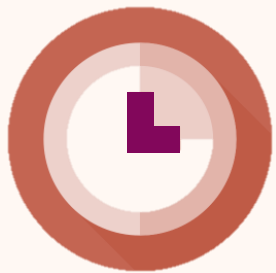
International, inter-sectoral and interdisciplinary mobility of R&I staff (“secondments”)

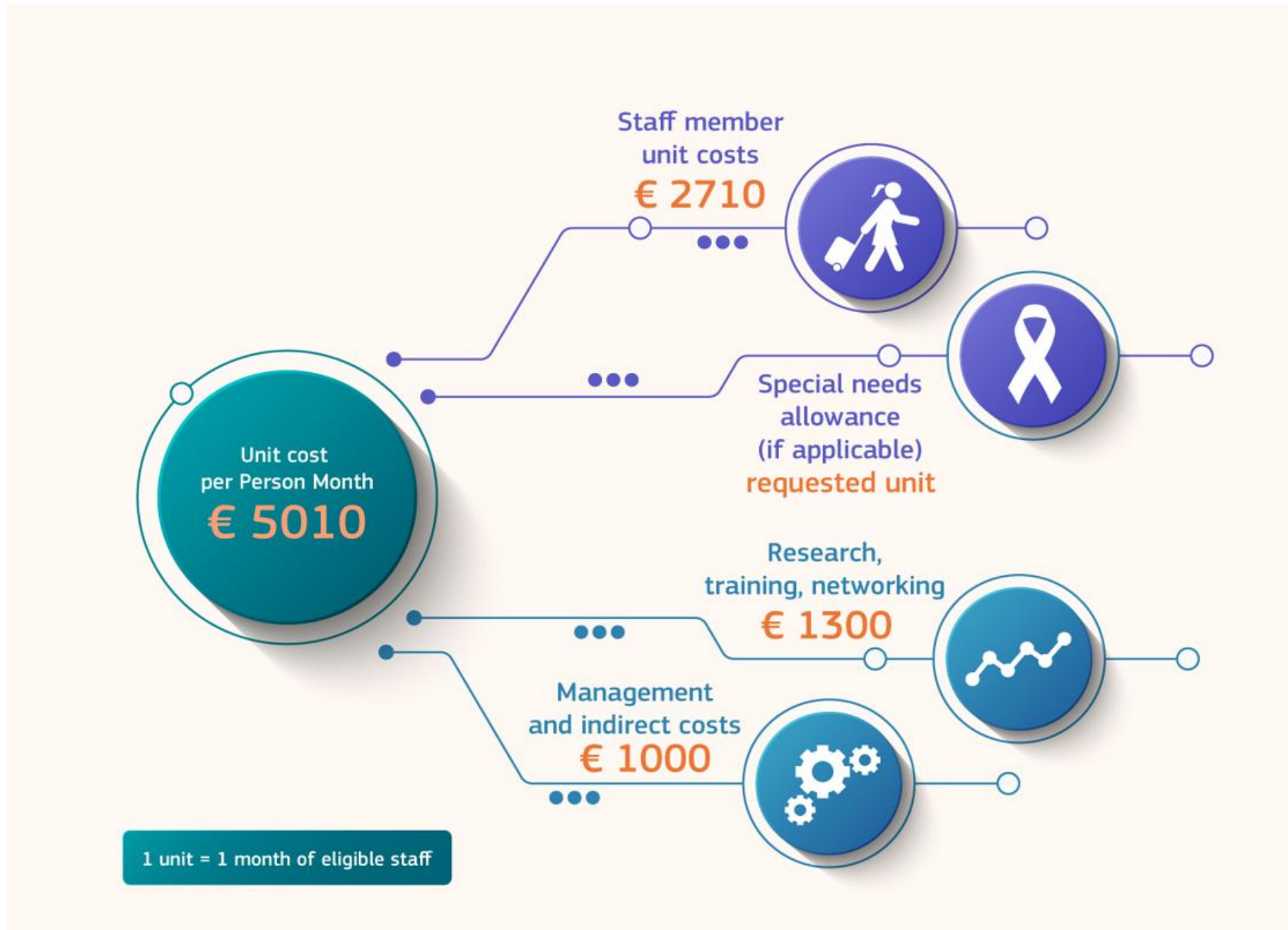
