Follow the rules of the game 😊

1) Publish in Open Access

As an EU-funded project, all the outputs from LEAP-RE (deliverables, documents, scientific contributions, etc.) must be **available in open-access**. For these, the EC has provided a new publishing platform named **Open Research Europe (ORE)** to allow peer-reviewed and open-access publication **free of charge**.



Main features: open peer review; open to a variety of publications (not just scientific articles); 100% waived fees and gold open access; indexed in PubMed and other bibliographic databases (e.g., Web of Science).

Follow the rules of the game 😊

2) Report your publications to the EC

All scientific publications issued from the project must be reported in the **continuous reporting module of the participant portal** provided by the EC, and proper links to the persistent identifiers and the versions deposited in open access repositories provided” – **All the WP leaders are encouraged to do so.**

All the scientific publications (in open access) must then be saved in a persistent and open **repository** that has been arranged in Zenodo (see next slide).

A tutorial on how to access the portal and upload publications has been shared among the consortium and is available here

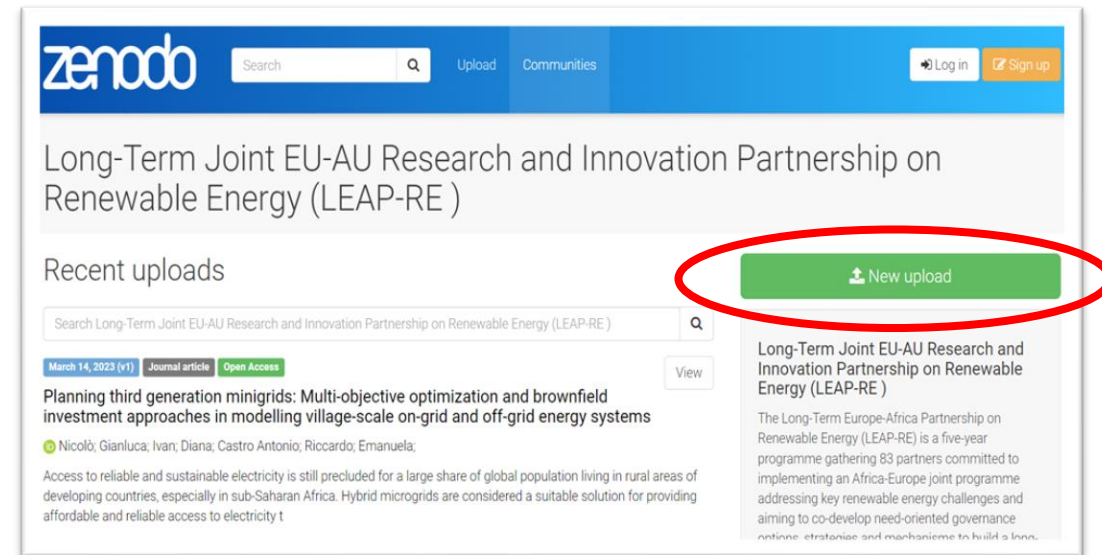

3) *Share your publications outside LEAP-RE*

The EC requires making **all the scientific publications stemming from the programme available** in a **persistent and open repository**.

The **Zenodo platform**, a multi-disciplinary open repository maintained by CERN within the OpenAIRE initiative, has been chosen for this scope. It complies with the data management requirements of Horizon Europe, the ERC and other EU research and innovation funding programmes.



You must **upload your new open-access publications** (articles, databases, etc.) by logging in to the platform. These will be approved in a reasonable time.
